Overview

Interested candidates should apply for Bachelor of Fine Arts (Honours) in Acting for Global Screen via JUPAS or Non-JUPAS route from Year 1. Subsequently, applicants will be invited by email to submit their portfolios. All portfolios from eligible applicants will be reviewed by admission panels. Only shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend Audition/Interview.

All portfolio submissions should be completed according to the deadline stated in the invitation email. Invitation of Portfolio Submission will be sent to the email address provided at the time of application. Please ensure the email information provided is correct. Late submission of portfolio will not be reviewed. If any requested item(s) stated in AGS Portfolio Specification is/are missing, the submission will be regarded as unsuccessful.

Portfolio Specification

A portfolio is a compilation of works that shows an applicant's areas of interest and strength, creativity potential, and suitability for admission to our programme. The excerpt of the work should show applicants' passion, eagerness and aspiration in entering the field of acting.

1. Performance Resume

A. Format

- Up to ten vertical A4 pages with 11pt font size
- In .pdf format

B. Content

The resume should include the following information:

- Applicant's full name
- Application number

The resume should cover the following areas:

- 1. Education background
- 2. Qualification and/or experience in performance
 - Dancing
 - Acting
 - Directing
 - Music (singing, instrument playing, composing, etc.)
 - Producing
 - Performance experience (e.g. stage, media, film, etc.)
 - Drama or Script writing
 - Other related disciplines
- 2. Awards received/ commendations with proof
- 3. Classes, workshops, special skills, special training attended

C. Size

The resume shall not exceed 10MB.

D. Remarks

- 1. All images pasted/inserted in the resume should be adjusted and compressed suitably in .jpeg format.
- 2. Pages beyond the 10th page may not be reviewed.

2. Audition Speeches

Please prepare <u>TWO filmed audition speeches and combine them into ONE video</u> in .mp4 or .mov format. Each speech should be about two to three minutes in duration.

The speeches should be from a contemporary film, television series or stage play, which are produced after the year of 1960. The two speeches should contrast each other.

Applicants are recommended to select the speeches that suit their age, gender, and casting range with the native voice and accent of theirs. It is also suggested for applicant to film their speeches with camera with a plain or neutral background and make sure the voice is clear.
